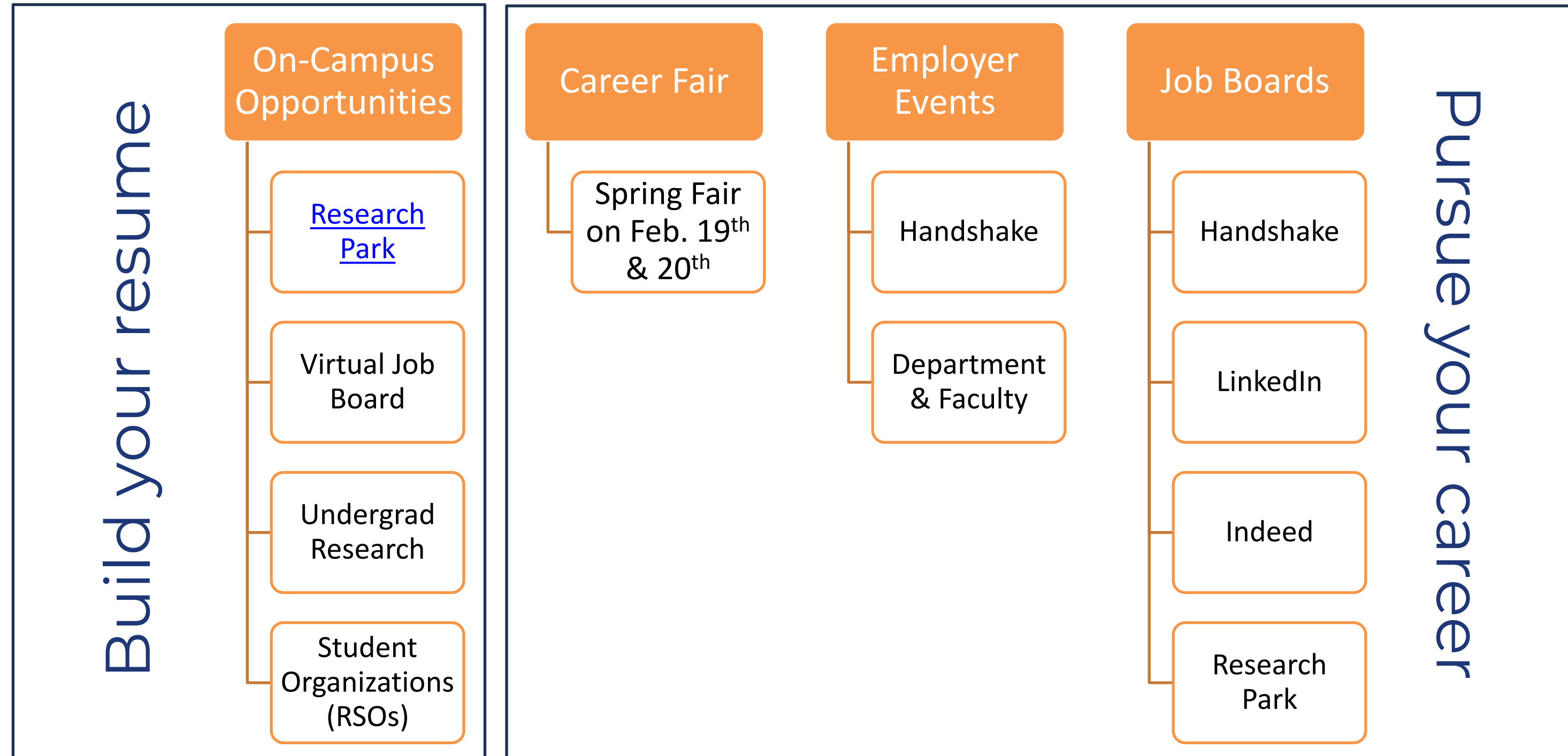

What is it, and why is it important?

For job/internship-seeking students and recent graduates:

- Event opportunities (fairs, networking, workshops, etc.)
- Make appointment w/ Career Coaches
- Search for jobs/internships
- Personalized job/internship recommendations
- Get spotted by employers
- Recruiters search students by “career interests”
- Review students’ uploaded documents

Appointments

Step-by-step process:

- Log onto Handshake-Career Center
- Appointments-schedule a new appointment-Engineering Career Services
- Type of appointment you want-time and date that works for your schedule

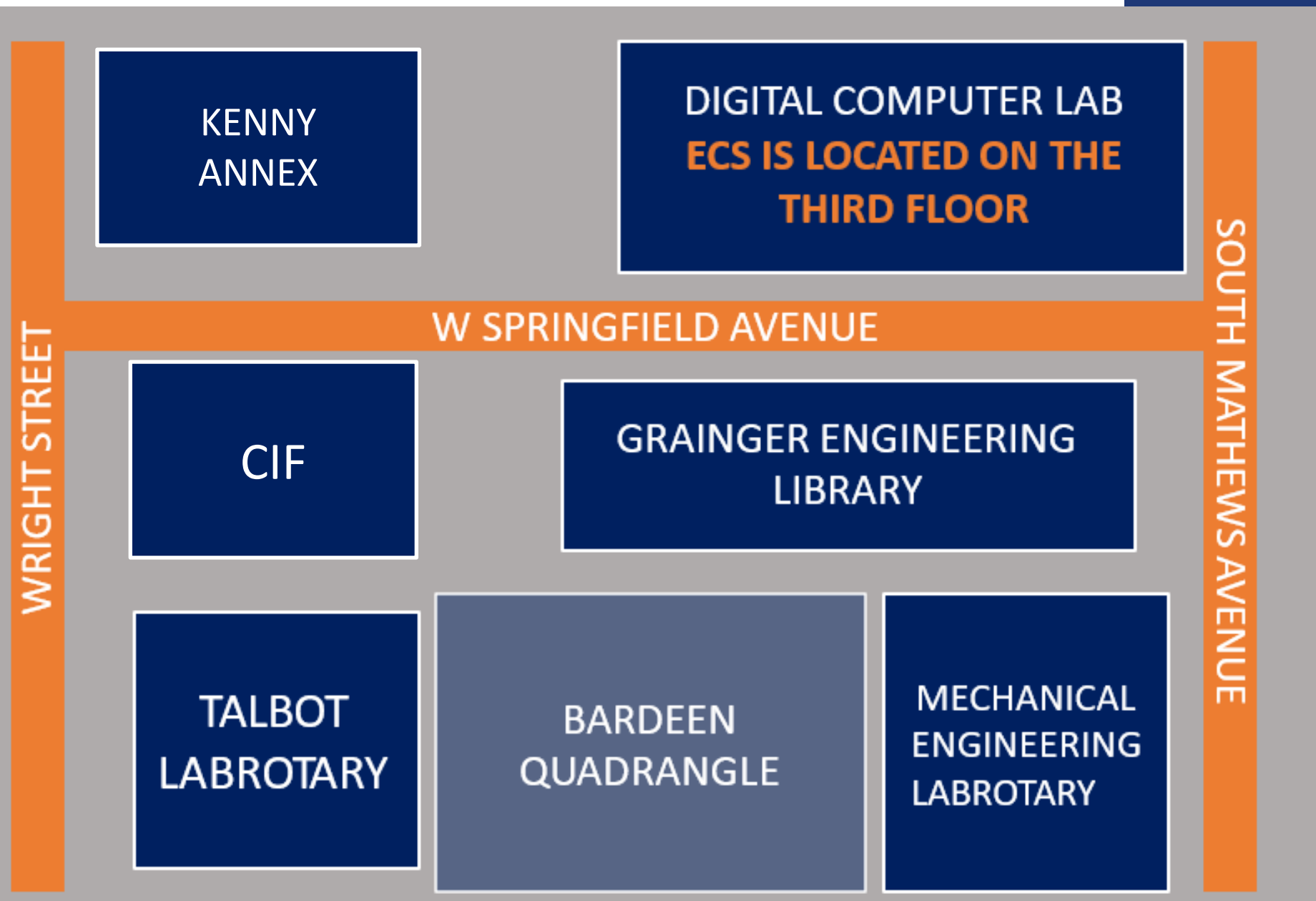


Fall Semester	Spring Semester	Typical Recruiting Stage
August - September	January - February	Engagement and Application Stage. Employers start to post positions, and are coming to campus for career fairs, info sessions, and tech talks to engage with potential candidates.
October - November	March - April	Interview Stage. Companies start to invite candidates after first round of engagement.
November - December	April - May	Offer Stage. Employers start to send out offers. But interviewing with candidates continues.
