

Homework Assignment #3, Title and Abstract

Use the same paper that you chose for last week's assignment. This homework consists of two parts:

1. Analyze the title of the paper, using the criteria presented in the January 19 class lecture. Is the paper's title concise and descriptive? Will it capture a busy reader's attention and interest? **Write** a one-paragraph evaluation of the title and either discuss what is good about the title or suggest how it might be improved.
2. Next, **write** an appropriate abstract for the paper, following the lessons from the February 2 lecture (remember MMRC!).

Be sure to clearly indicate on your submission which paper you are writing about.
