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The more obviously false F is, the better. Examples:

• The sum of the vertex degrees in the graph is odd.

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- The sum of the vertex degrees in the graph is odd.
- 0 = 1
- Purdue's marching band is better than the Marching Illini.

Key steps in a proof by contradiction:

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- 3 Take logical steps that end at a logical contradiction.
- **4** "This is a contradiction. Therefore, [p]."

A Worked Example

Prove $\sqrt{3}$ is irrational.

Proof.

The proof is by contradiction. Suppose $\sqrt{3}$ is rational.

This is a contradiction. Therefore, $\sqrt{3}$ is irrational.
