- Final Exam is worth 35% of the course grade
- Final course grade is based on 400 possible points
  - 100 pts – Exam 1
  - 100 pts – Exam 2
  - 60 pts – Quizzes (average all quiz scores, less the lowest 2, and scale to 60)
  - 140 pts – Final Exam
- Final course grade will be curved based on points achieved out of 400
- Final details:
  - 140-point test
    - 100/140 pts will be on new material (i.e., material covered since Exam 2)
    - 40/140 pts will be on comprehensive material (i.e., material from the whole semester)

- There is a practice exam on the course website (the Spring 2013 Final Exam) that has a similar format to our Final – note that I removed a couple problems that were on material we didn't cover this semester, so the points don't quite add up to 140.
